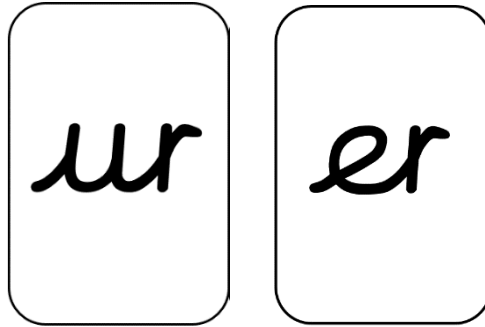


Tuesday 5th May 2020

We have learnt 2 new sounds that both make the same sound.



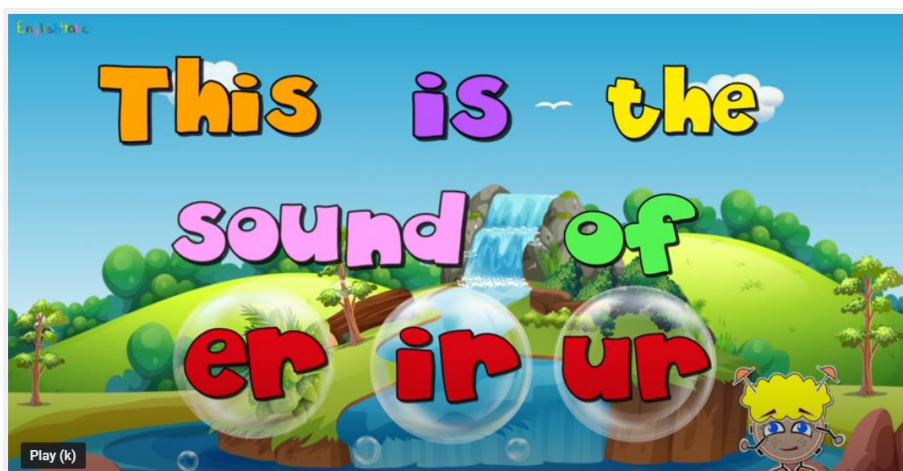
The Phonics Fairy says

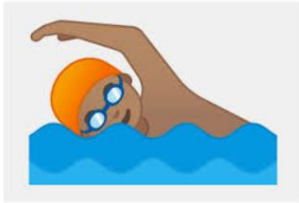
