

Let's start today by playing Phonics Splat! Spread out your sound cards on the floor. Call out a sound and ask your child to 'splat' the correct card.

They could use anything to be their splatter, it could be a wooden spoon, a magic wand or just their hand! Swap over and ask them to call out the sounds, make some mistakes when splatting, do they notice and correct you?!

Now let's practise using our sounds to read words. Load the 'Phase 3 Quick Read' powerpoint below. (Also uploaded as a PDF for those who are unable to access powerpoint). Ask your child to read the word on the screen, encouraging them to use their sounds. When you click again an image will be revealed, did they get the word right?





Alternatively, you could select words for your child to read from their blending bookmarks and then ask them to draw a picture to match.

You could practise writing some simple sentences using some of the words e.g. The fox ran fast. Use your sound mat to help you.
