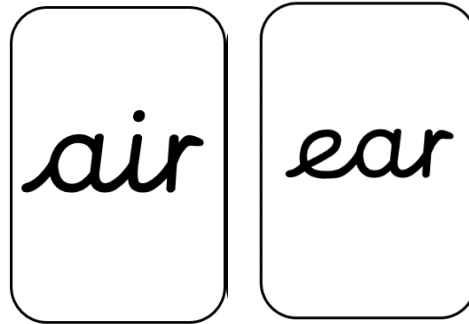


Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2020
