Sound	Visual	Action	Digraph Rhyme
.air		Wag finger	air, air that's not fair!
.ear		Put hand to ear	ear, ear hear with your ear.

Use your sounds to write some sentences about the picture.

You could use the phrase - 'I can see a ...' or you can write your own sentence such as 'They are in the garden.'

Remember your child needs to be writing this phonetically and as independently as possible, it **does not** have to be spelt correctly.

E.g.

It is sunee. (It is sunny.)

I can see sosijis cooking. (I can see sausages cooking.)

The flowers are pink, purpl and wight. (The flowers are pink, purple and white.)
