Dragons are very important in Chinese culture. They are especially used in celebrations, such as Chinese New Year.












How to make a Chinese Dragon




You will need: dragon head and tail template, coloured card, colouring pens or pencils, wooden sticks, scissors, glue and tape.




1. Start by cutting out the head and tail template and colour in. BE ADVENTUROUS!




2. Cut an A4 piece of paper in half length-ways and fold it backwards and forwards to make a concertina.



3. Glue the concertina card to the coloured head and tail.




4. Tape two wooden sticks onto the back of the dragon.



5. Now you are ready to dance with your Chinese Dragon!






