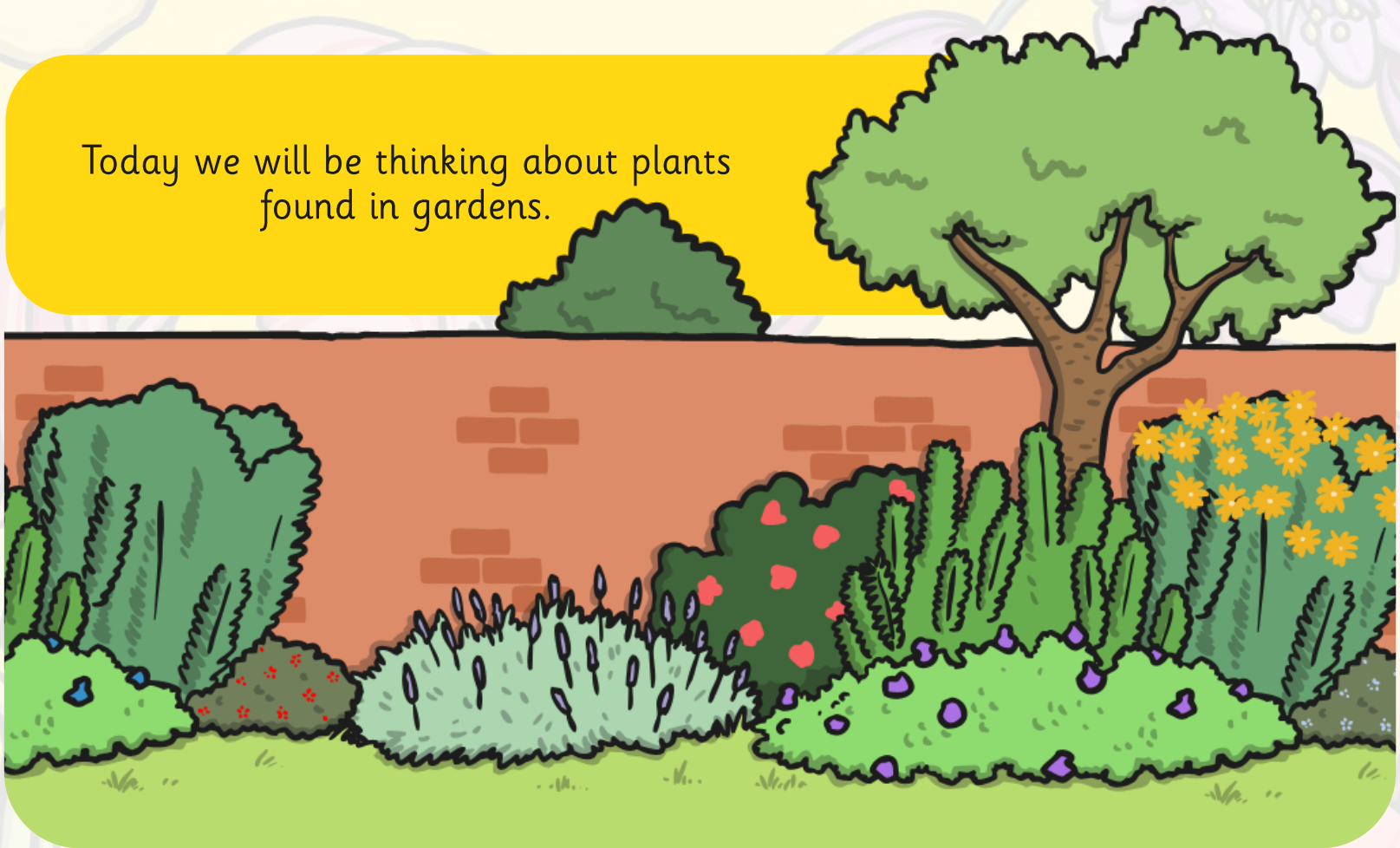

Gardens are places where people grow plants.

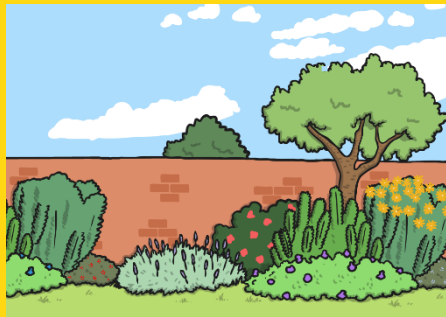
Some people grow plants because they are nice to look at.

Some people use their gardens for growing things to eat.

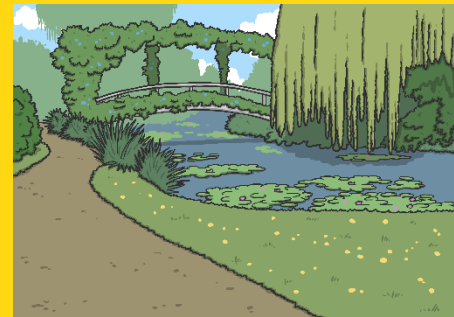
You can plant your bean plant in a garden when you take it home.

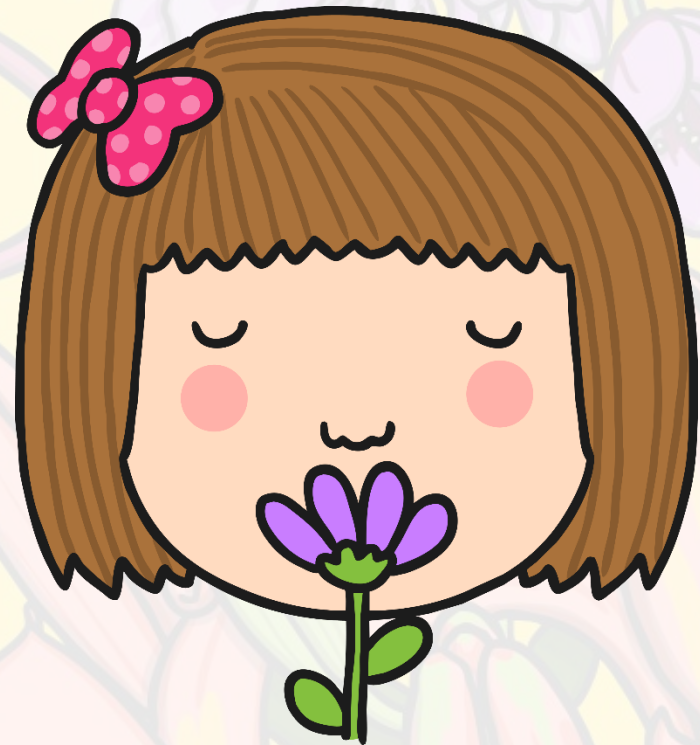
Great Gardens

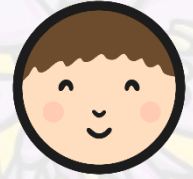

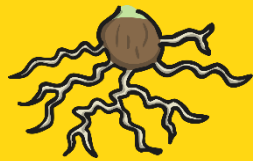
I Spy Plants

Can you see the petals?



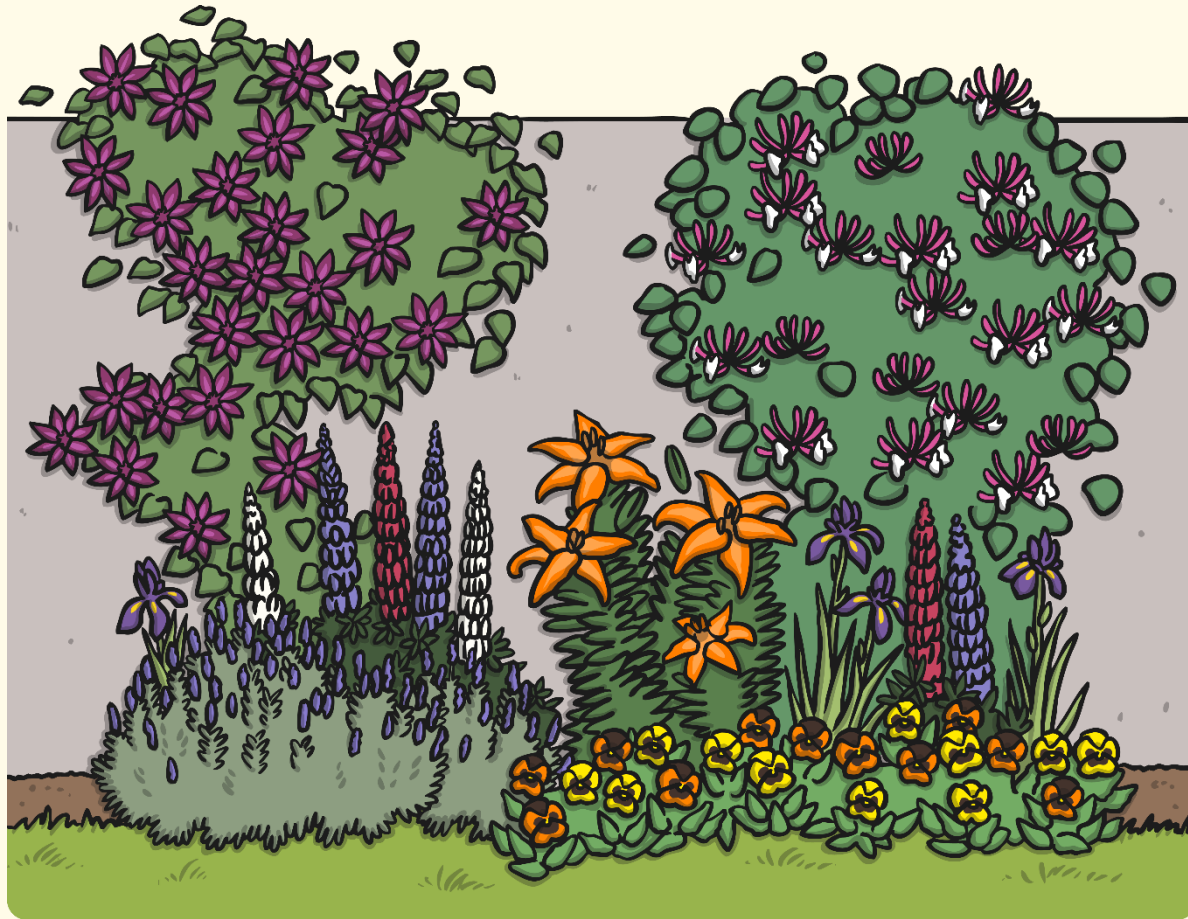
