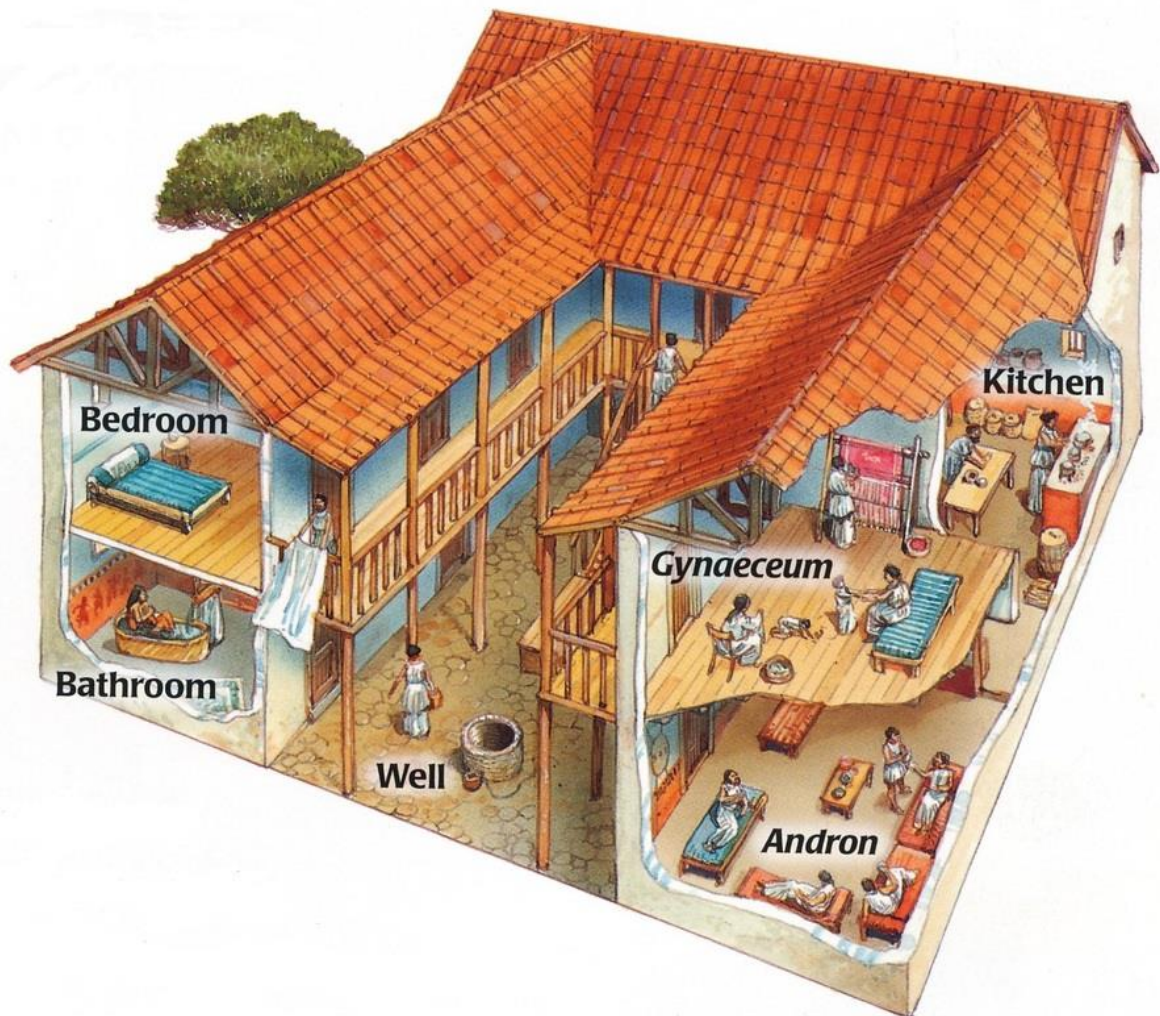


What was everyday like in Ancient Greece?
