Data Handling - Bar Charts

Warm up

Activities

Explain that today we are going to be collecting new information/data. If you are able to look out of a window, or sit safely outside your house, you can collect information about traffic that passes. Explain that we will be looking for cars, bikes, scooters, motorbikes and people walking. Set the clock for 20 minutes to watch and collect the data (again using a tally chart template). If lots of cars pass your area, you could alternatively do a survey on car

colours. Next, look at the data and see which mode of transport was the most popular? How many bikes did we see? How

many cars? Instead of a pictogram like yesterday, we are going to make a bar chart! Show picture example.

Use the template below or draw your own. Ask your child to count the squares and colour how many they saw of each mode of transport. The bar that is highest shows the transport that was most popular. Which was least popular? Please take photos and share on evidence me!
