




Here is the Blending Bookmark for the sound *oa*. Have a quick practise at reading the words.

Now let's try the new Blending Bookmark!

Blending Bookmark - <i>oa</i> (part 2) <i>toasted</i> <i>groaned</i> <i>raincoat</i> <i>foaming</i> <i>roasting</i> <i>floating</i> <i>soaking</i> <i>cockroach</i> <i>loading</i> <i>speedboat</i>

Talk about this picture together, what can you see?



Point to the sound bubbles and ask your child to say each sound. Write a label for the items in the picture, make sure you include the sound in the bubble.

(You can print the picture below or just write a list on a separate piece of paper).

You could also write some sentences using the items that you have labelled.
