

Brazil is home to the largest rainforest in the world, the Amazon rainforest. Rainforests are very hot and humid places where lots of plants and animals live.


I took a trip into the rainforest. What animals do you think I saw?








The Amazon River is the second longest river in the world. It mostly runs through rainforests. The Amazon river flows through Brazil and several other countries in South America.
