WALT: describe a Jewish Bar or Bat Mitzvah ceremony

- What are you looking forward to when you become an adult?
- What will you be able to do?
- What responsibilities will you have as an adult?

We are looking at Judaism. What can you remember about Judaism? What is the Jewish holy book called? Where do Jews go to worship?

An important ceremony in a Jewish person's life is the Bar Mitzvah for boys and Bat Mitzvah for girls. This ceremony marks the move for Jewish young people from childhood to adulthood. At this time, Jewish young people are considered responsible for their own actions and old enough to follow the mitzvot (commandments) for themselves.
