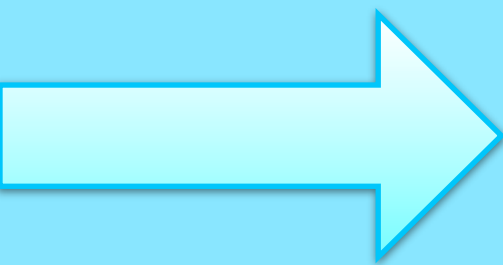


# Around the World

**Today we will be...**

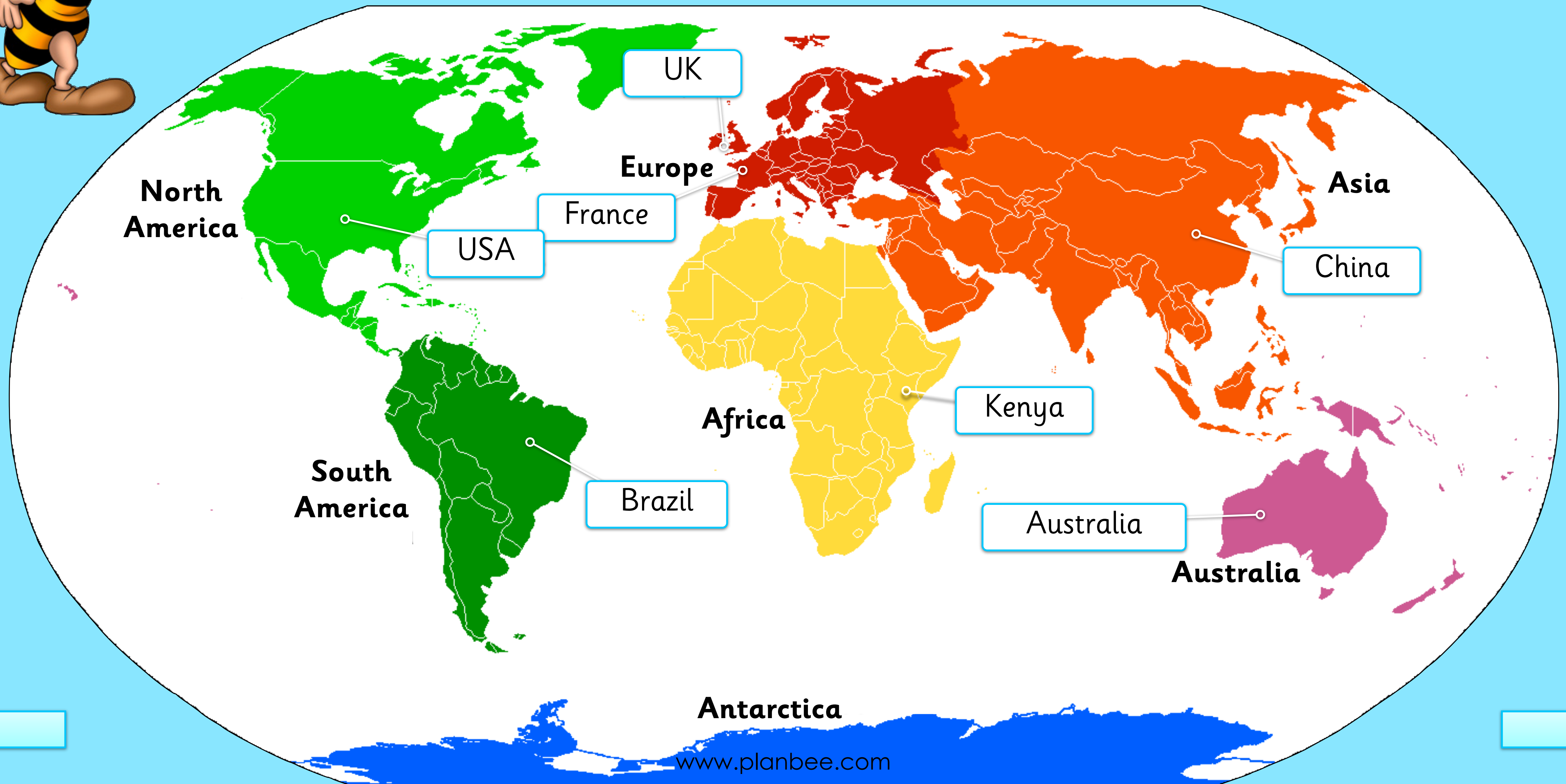
Finding out where Antarctica is and what it is like there.





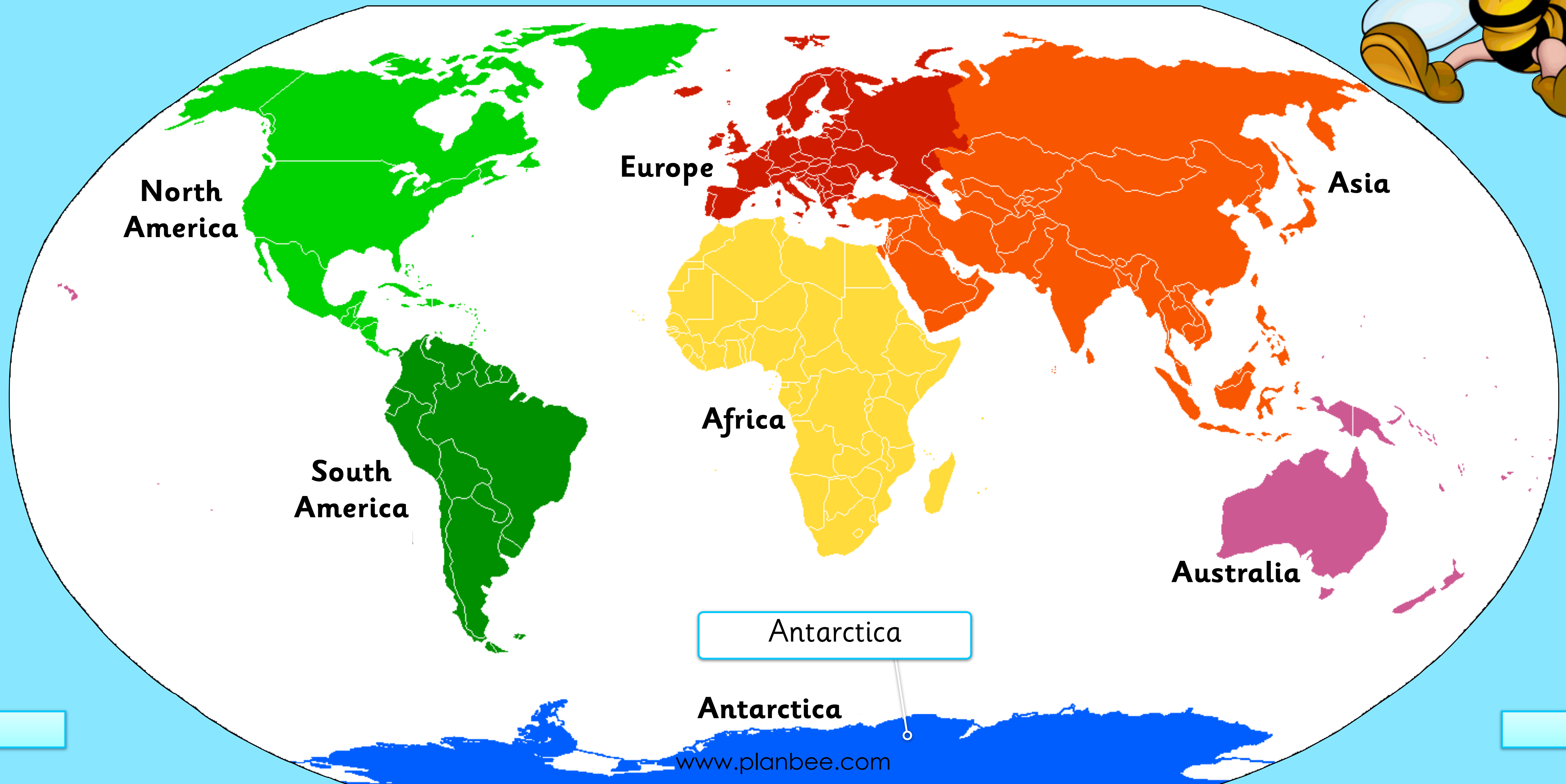


So far, I have travelled to six of the seven continents of the world. Which is the only continent I haven't visited so far?
