Let's start today's phonics session by practising singing the alphabet song again!

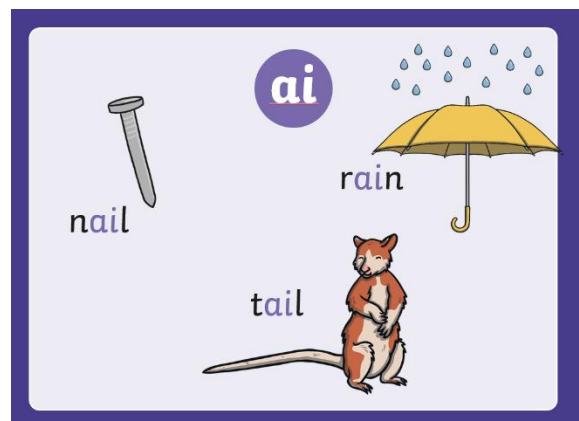
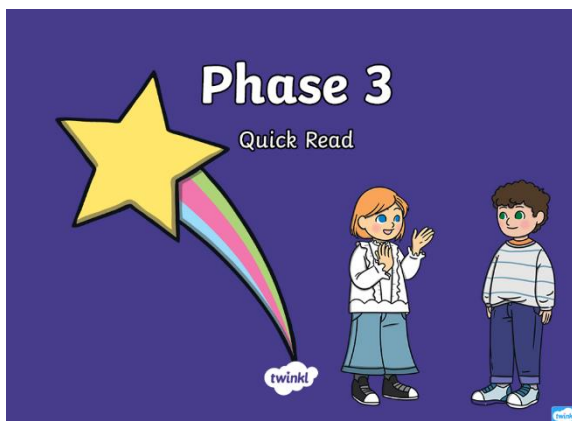

Practise reading these sounds with their rhyme ...

ch sh th ng ai ay ee
igh ie oo oo oa

Now let's practise using these sounds to read words. Load the 'Phase 3 Quick Read' powerpoint below. (Also uploaded as a PDF for those who are unable to access powerpoint). Ask your child to read the word on the screen, encouraging them to use their sounds. When you click again an image will be revealed, did they get the word right?



Play a game of I spy using the images below. All of these pictures have a sh, ch, th or ng sound in them. Can you write the words using your sounds? Use your sound mat to help you. You could challenge yourself and write a sentence for some of them too.
