Salah – Pillar Two

This pillar is prayer. Muslims pray five times a day and follow a special ritual to do so. First they must wash in symbolically clean water.

All the prayers are said at the same time every day.

Fajr - Morning, between dawn and sunrise.

Zuhr - Mid-day or early afternoon.


Asr - Late afternoon.



Maghrib - Evening, around sunset.

Isah - Night, before going to bed.
