
Hidden meanings

A **parable** is a story told by Jesus that teaches us something important. Parables can have hidden meanings, where they say one thing but mean something else. One of the hidden meanings in the parable 'the lost son' is all about forgiveness.

Some hidden meanings within the story:

- 1. God is forgiving, just like the father in the story
- 2. God is loving, just like a parent
- 3. It is okay to make mistakes
- 4. Forgiving people is important when they make mistakes

Can you think of a time when you forgave someone?
