


Reception classes will start to receive certificates when they start full time in school.

SOCIAL DISTANCING



Thank you so much to those parents who are setting good examples for children and others to follow regarding social distancing. In light of local lockdowns in other parts of the country, I would like to remind parents how important it is for us to maintain social distancing so that we can remain open for our children to attend school. Other things I would like to remind you of are:

- 1. Ensuring your child is on time for allotted staggered starting time. This also means not dropping them off early for any reason at all! This defeats our social distancing rules that we have to implement.
- 2. On collection of your child at the end of the day, leave the school premises immediately. Please do not be offended if staff are asking you to move on; we are only trying to follow the guidelines.
- 3. If you are waiting to collect another children at a different time slot, <u>do not</u> let the children you have already collected play or socialise with others. This is cross-contaminating the class bubbles we have set up to ensure your children's safety.
- 4. If your child or anyone in your household displays the COVID symptoms, do not send them into school. See the flow chart below.

We completely understand that this 'new normal' thing can be difficult to get used to and that government guidelines may not always be clear. As a school, we are expected to have policies and procedures in place to ensure the safety of everyone who comes into contact with our school. Those policies and procedures are even more important in light of COVID. It has come to our attention that there have been some encounters between parents to parents and parents to staff. We urge you to be kind and courteous to everyone as well as understanding during these difficult and stressful times. Please make sure that you abide by the request that only one person in the office foyer at a time to ensure social distancing and protection of everyone including children, parents and staff. Aggression and rudeness will not be tolerated towards our staff who ensure the care and safety of your children on a daily basis.
