Below is an overview of the sounds that the children will be learning this unit with some examples of words that they are found in.

Please could you reinforce these sounds with your children when you see them in books that they are reading, if they are writing or possibly as a game to spot a spelling pattern in words.

NB. The children will be tested on words appropriate for their level. E.g. onesyllable or two-syllable

This unit, we are looking at the following sounds:

sh - shhhh (finger to lips)

ch - ch ch ch chick (flap like a chick)

ng – a thing on a string (bounce hand up and down)

th - th th th thumb (both thumbs up)
