Below is an overview of the sounds that the children will be learning this unit with some examples of words that they are found in.

Please could you reinforce these sounds with your children when you see them in books that they are reading, if they are writing or possibly as a game to spot a spelling pattern in words.

NB. The children will be tested on words appropriate for their level. E.g. one-syllable or two-syllable

This unit, we are looking at the following sounds:

ai - snail in the rain (fingers demonstrating rain) ay - may I play (hands out as if asking a question) a-e - make a cake (mixing a spoon in a bowl)



(ay is always used at the end of a word: play, stay, ai is always used in the middle of a word: rain, stain)
