Let's begin by practising the sounds we have learnt so far...



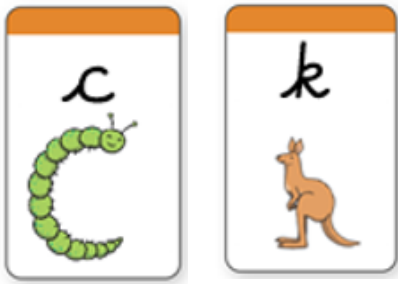
Today we are learning a new sound.



This is k.

The action for k is placing 2 fingers on the top of the other hand and making them jump like a kangaroo.



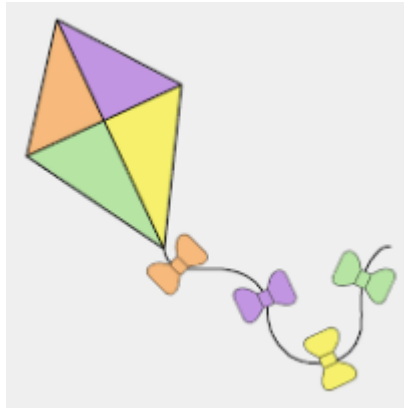
c and k make the same sound, they both go at the beginning of words, this k goes at the end of words too.

Look at the pictures below, which ones start with a 'k' sound?

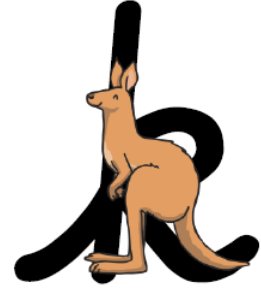


*This is how we write this sound...*
