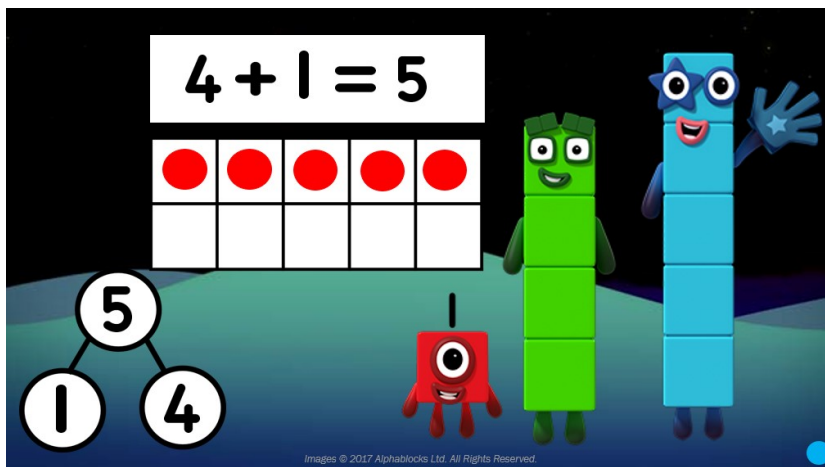


Watch the Number Blocks video on the number 5.

How did 5 appear in the video? I jumped onto 4's shoulders and 5 appeared! Look at the part-part-whole model below and see how 1 and 4 together make 5.



Go and collect 5 things to count with and use your part-part-whole model from your maths folder to find the other parts that can make 5. What did you find?

$$4 + 1 = 5$$

$$2 + 3 = 5$$

$$0 + 5 = 5$$

Find 5 things in your house that represent 5. Here is what I found...

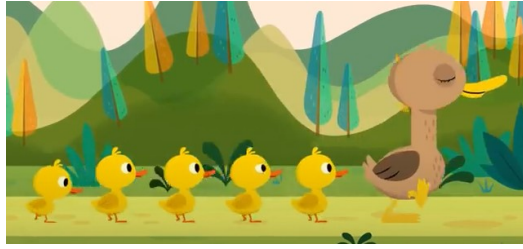

Can you draw the digit 5? Watch this video to help you.

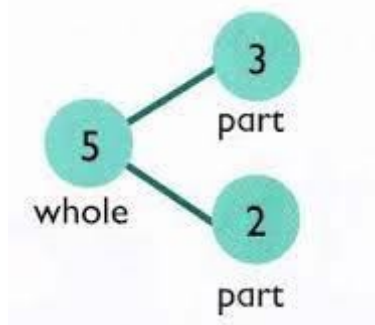
