#### **COVID UPDATES**

Reception class are at home learning for this week but will be back on Friday. The have worked very well over the past week on their remote home learning and joined in with their daily live lessons and work from the school website. Please remember if your child has to self-isolate for a suspected case that the class teachers have pre-prepared work on the class pages for the children to complete whilst at home. If you would rather have paper copies of work please let your class teacher's or the office know so we can organise that for you.

At school we continue to do everything in our power to reduce any risk of transmission. There is no movement or contact between bubbles for the children. There is a very robust cleaning schedule and understanding by the children and staff of the routines and expectations at this time. Hopefully, we will not have to take further steps to close bubbles. However, we do need parents to play their part as well. From now on if parents do not wear masks I would ask you not to come onto the school site and meet the children at the gate. Thank you.

I will be running another parental feedback and consultation session on Friday 4 December at 1.45pm, which last time was very positive. The meeting will take no more than one hour depending on what there is to discuss. I will send out the Zoom code and password the day before to parents and will operate as parents evenings have done with a waiting room to ensure we are secure.

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

## A reminder about when and when not to send your children to school

If you or your child or older siblings at different school have sypmtoms of Covid 19 you must self-isolate immediately until you have have a test and the results have been returned. Please ensure you inform the school as soon as you can to inform the office as we have to report all suspected and positive cases to Public Health England on the same day. A letter is being emailed alongside the newsletter with information about work being sent home if your child has to self-isolate. Please note work will not be sent home for other absences as is normal practice unless due to a hospital stay and recovery for a specific reason. government have written a letter to all parents setting out when you should and should not have your child tested.
