COVID UPDATES

Unfortunately, we had to close Miss Hake's class bubble due to a positive case within the class. Once again they have been having live teaching sessions on a daily basis and completing their work. We continue to maintain our social distancing and constant hygiene regime in school. Can I remind parents to maintain their social distancing in the playground and car park when collecting the children and keep their own children together and away from children in other bubble classes. Within school these do not mix and should not at the end of the day either.

VIRTUAL CROSS COUNTRY

The whole school took part in the Virtual Cross Country challenge to see how far we could run if we all ran individually then added the distances altogether. We are so pleased by the efforts of the children. All the children who took part paced themselves brilliantly with many chatting to their friends as they ran. They were all cheering each other on and came in with big smiles on their faces! In fact the distance they all ran was 179.2km, which would take them past Windsor Castle and nearly all the way to Buckingham Palace in London.

CHRISTMAS

The children will be able to bring in Christmas cards as from Thursday 3 December for their class bubble and then on a Monday and Thursday each week or in the case of KS1 the days in which the children bring their reading folders to school. They will then be distributed after being quarantined. We are looking forward to the other events we have planned for the coming weeks.



A reminder about when and when not to send your children to school

If you or your child or older siblings at different school have sypmtoms of Covid 19 you must self-isolate immediately until you have have a test and the results have been returned. Please ensure you inform the school as soon as you can to inform the office as we have to report all suspected and positive cases to Public Health England on the same day. A letter is being emailed alongside the newsletter with information about work being sent home if your child has to self-isolate.
