


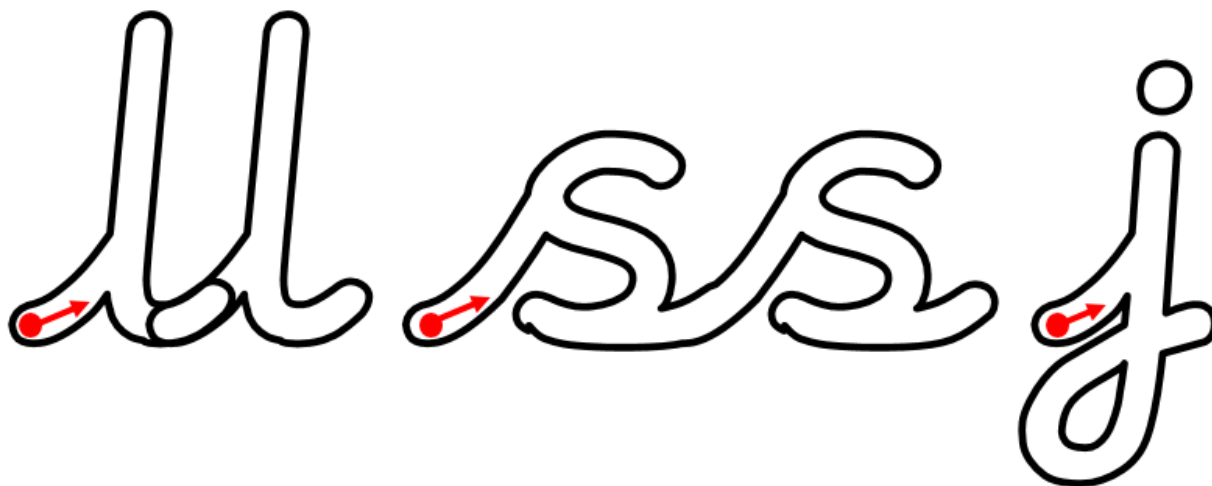


Reception Phonics

This week we have learnt 3 new sounds, practise them at home.

Sound	Visual	Action	Letter Formation Rhyme
ll	bell 	Move both hands up and down as if ringing 2 hand bells.	This sound has 2 letters so we say that they are friends and hold hands. There are no letter formation rhymes for digraphs or trigraphs (sounds with 2/ 3 letters).
ss	grass 	Wiggle arm forwards like a snake slithering in the grass.	This sound has 2 letters so we say that they are friends and hold hands. There are no letter formation rhymes for digraphs or trigraphs (sounds with 2/ 3 letters).
j	Jack in a box 	Push fist up into the air, then open hand, to represent a jack-in-the-box.	Whoosh up, down the body and curl and a dot for the head.
