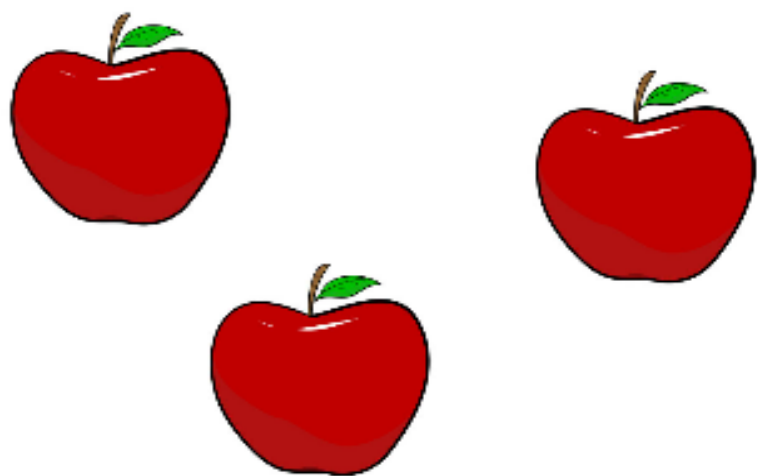

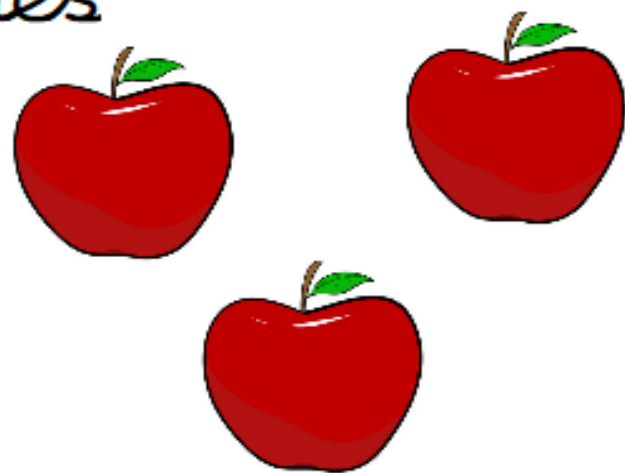

$$3 + 3 =$$

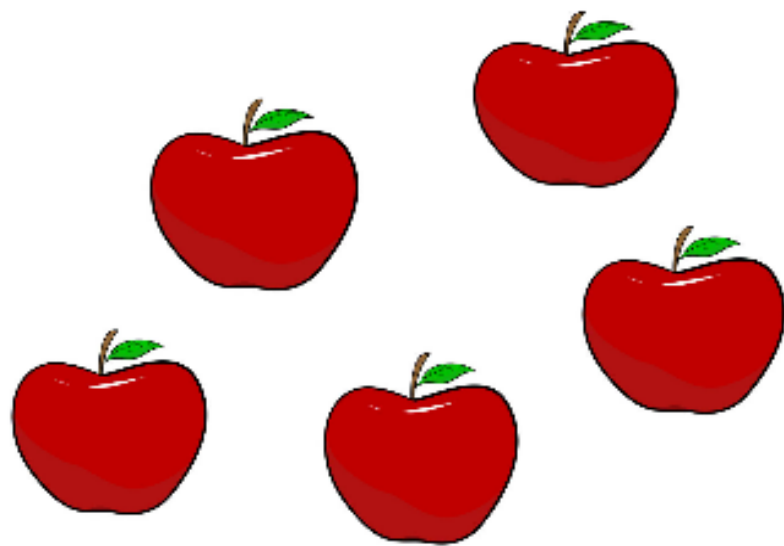
I have another 3 apples
