Let's look at a couple together.

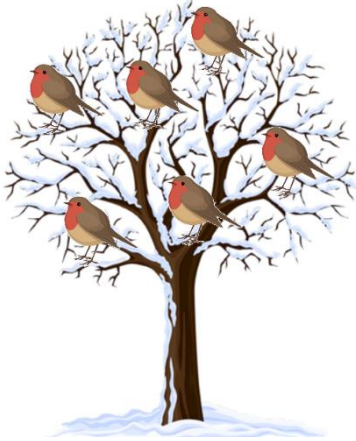
How many birds are in the tree?

6

There are 6 birds in the tree. 2 birds flew away to find some food. How many are left?

What number sentence would go with this story?

$$6 - 2 = 4$$

What is the corresponding number sentence?

$$5 - 2 = 3$$
