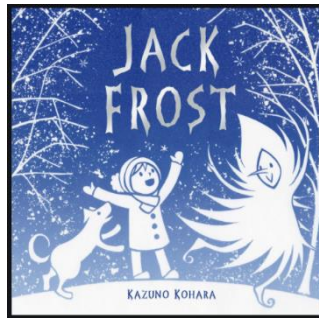


Reception Home Learning 6th - 8th January 2021

Here are some activity ideas linked to winter.

Please choose at least one activity from the list below, or you could make up your own, to complete each day.

Go for a family walk and look for signs of winter. Take photos of what you find.	Make a bird feeder to feed the birds.	Freeze items in water then explore melting the ice.
Make a paper snowflake using scissors.	Make a picture/collage of Jack Frost or a winter scene.	Find out about animals that hibernate, can you write a list of them?
Make a scarf with a repeating pattern, you could use paint, chalk, pens etc.	Make a snow globe from a jam jar.	Make a hot chocolate with marshmallows and share your favourite winter story.
Design a jumper for the boy in the Jack Frost story to keep him warm.	Make a snowman using 2D shapes.	Use playdough, buttons and ribbons to make snowmen. Try to make different sizes.
Sort clothes for winter and summer and talk about why you need them.	Join in with Cosmic Kids Winter Yoga online.	Fill a tray with salt and glitter, use your finger to practise writing letters and numbers.
