LESSON 1

You can complete these activities by:

Gold

<u>Mapping Activity</u>: Use the Map of the World sheet. Locate and label Mexico, Spain, Bahamas and the UK. Then plot the journey of Christopher Columbus.

<u>Timeline Activity</u>: Use the Aztec website http://www.aztec-history.com/aztec-timeline.html and choose at least 6 Aztec events on a timeline. Create your timeline on a piece of paper – remember to use a ruler! Then photograph and submit to your teacher.

Challenge: Include another civilisation event on the timeline e.g. Henry VIII

<u>Writing Activity</u>: Write a diary/journal entry for 3 consecutive days pretending to be either Christopher Columbus or Cortez about your voyage to 'the New Land'. It could be about meeting the natives for the first time, the discovery of gold etc.

Silver

<u>Mapping Activity</u>: Use the Map of the World sheet. Locate and label Mexico, Spain, Bahamas and the UK. Then plot the journey of Christopher Columbus.

<u>Timeline Activity</u>: Use the Ancient Maya Timeline (Silver and Bronze Timeline Activity Lesson 1) to create your own timeline on a piece of paper – remember to use a ruler! Then photograph and submit to your teacher.
