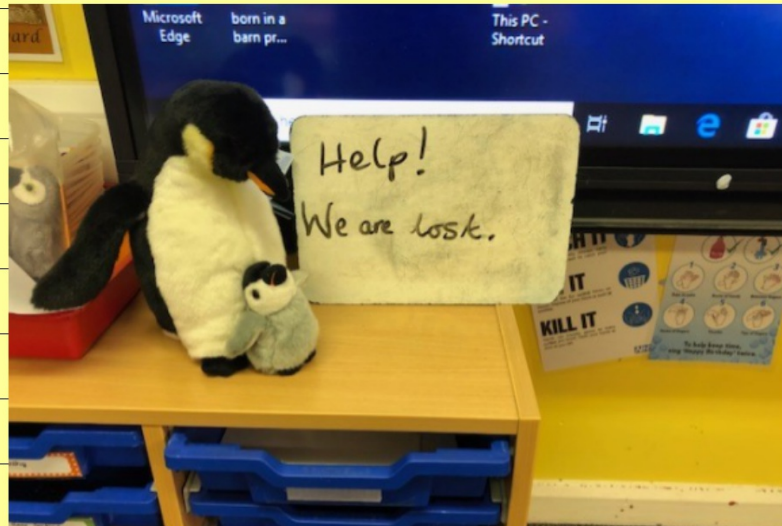

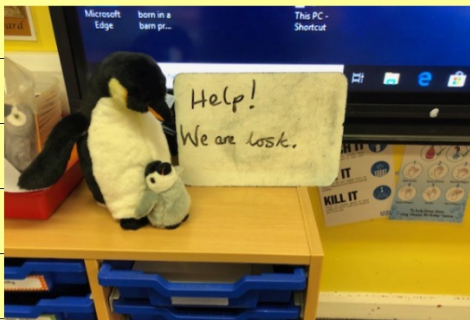

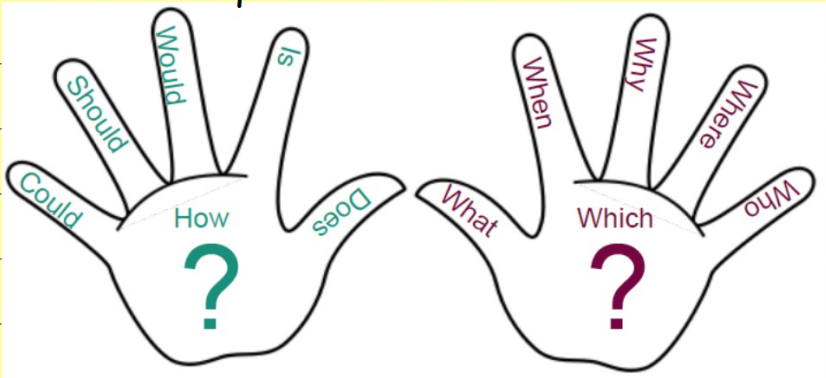

What questions could we ask to find out more information?

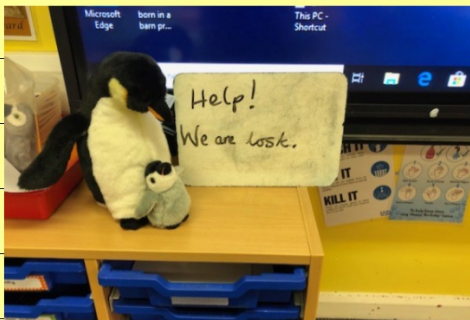
Use the question starters

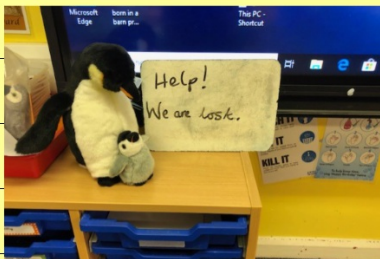
How can we help the penguins?
