Parents keeping your children and you **safe**



What to do if there is a confirmed case of Covid-19 at your child's school:

I have one child at school and their bubble is closed due to a confirmed case.

- Do not come to school for any reason
- Isolate for 14 days
- Only get a test if your child develops symptoms
- The rest of the household can act as normal

Send your child back on the return date given by school, unless they develop symptoms.

I have a child/ children at a school with a confirmed case. The case is in a bubble class which my child/ children are not in.

 Send your child/children to school as normal

I have two children at the same school.
One of my children's bubbles is closed due to a confirmed case.

- The child in the closed bubble must isolate for 14 days and not come to school
- Siblings in open bubbles must attend school as normal

Send your child in the affected bubble back on the return date given by school, unless they develop symptoms.

Stop the spread.

Do the right thing.
