Here are some activity ideas linking to the story.

Please choose at least one activity from the list below, or you could make up your own, to complete each day.

Make jam tarts or cakes for Little Red Riding Hood's basket.	Find as many red items at home as you can. Draw or write down what you find.	Make a map from Little Red Riding Hood's house to Grandma's house.
Make character puppets and retell the story.	Make a wolf mask, maybe you could make a collage.	Use playdough to make food to take to Granny's house.
Make a wanted poster for the wolf and describe who you are looking for.	Lister to the song 'Sam the Sham and the Pharaohs - Little Red Riding Hood' and move like the wolf to the music.	Design a new cape for Little Red Riding Hood, maybe she would like a spotty cape or a rainbow cape!
Use construction toys such as Lego, or junk modelling materials to make a basket to hold some food.	Stranger danger – Little Red Riding Hood spoke to the wolf but she didn't know him, he was a stranger. What should she have done?	Explore mixing red paint with different colours to make different shades of red.
Find things beginning with 'r', 'g' and 'w' around your house.	Join in online with Little Yoga Stars Little Red Riding Hood yoga.	Role-play a picnic at home with food, plates, cups and a blanket.
