Here are some activity ideas linking to the story.

Please choose at least one activity from the list below, or you could make up your own, to complete each day.

Build a house for a little pig, you could use Lego, Duplo, junk modelling resources etc.	Decorate a biscuit to look like a pig.	Find out some facts about pigs using the internet or books, ask a grown up to help you write them down.
Make character puppets and retell the story.	Draw a pig then use your phonics sounds to label it - leg, tail, nose, head etc.	Do your best wolf and pig impression!
Build a den.	Collage the three houses using different arts and craft materials.	Think of words that rhyme with huff and puff, ask a grown up to help you write them.
Design your own house, what would you have inside? A bouncy castle, a swimming pool, a park!!	Play 'What's the Time Mr Wolf?!	Build a house/tower with playing cards, then huff and puff it down!
Join in with Cosmic Kids On the Farm yoga.	Make a musical instrument and use it to sing the song Old Macdonald had a farm.	Using blocks or bricks, roll a dice and add that number of blocks/bricks to your tower, who will make the tallest tower?
