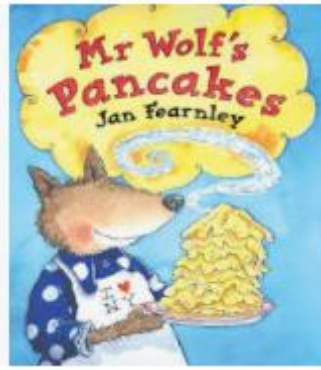


Reception Home Learning 8th February - 12th February 2021

Here are some activity ideas linking to the story.

Please choose at least one activity from the list below, or you could make up your own, to complete each day.

Make pancakes, which toppings will you have?	Write or draw a shopping list of pancake ingredients.	Have a pancake race!
Make music with frying pans and spoons, try to follow a rhythm or tune.	Play shops, using real coins. Make price tags then choose 2 things to buy, adding the prices together.	Make an invitation for a pancake party.
What coins can you find in your house? Look closely at the coins, can you sort them into groups by colour or value? Do you know how much any of them are worth?	Talk about the different ingredients used to make pancakes, find out where they come from.	Practise using the scales to weigh various items in your kitchen, which is the heaviest, which is the lightest?
Talk about the different characters in the story, which stories do you recognise them from?	Play cafes, pretend to take the orders, cook and serve the food.	Create an assault course for your pancake race.
Engage in some sensory messy play using flour or gloop!	Draw a pancake with your favourite toppings, can you use your sounds to label it?	Do some coin rubbings.
