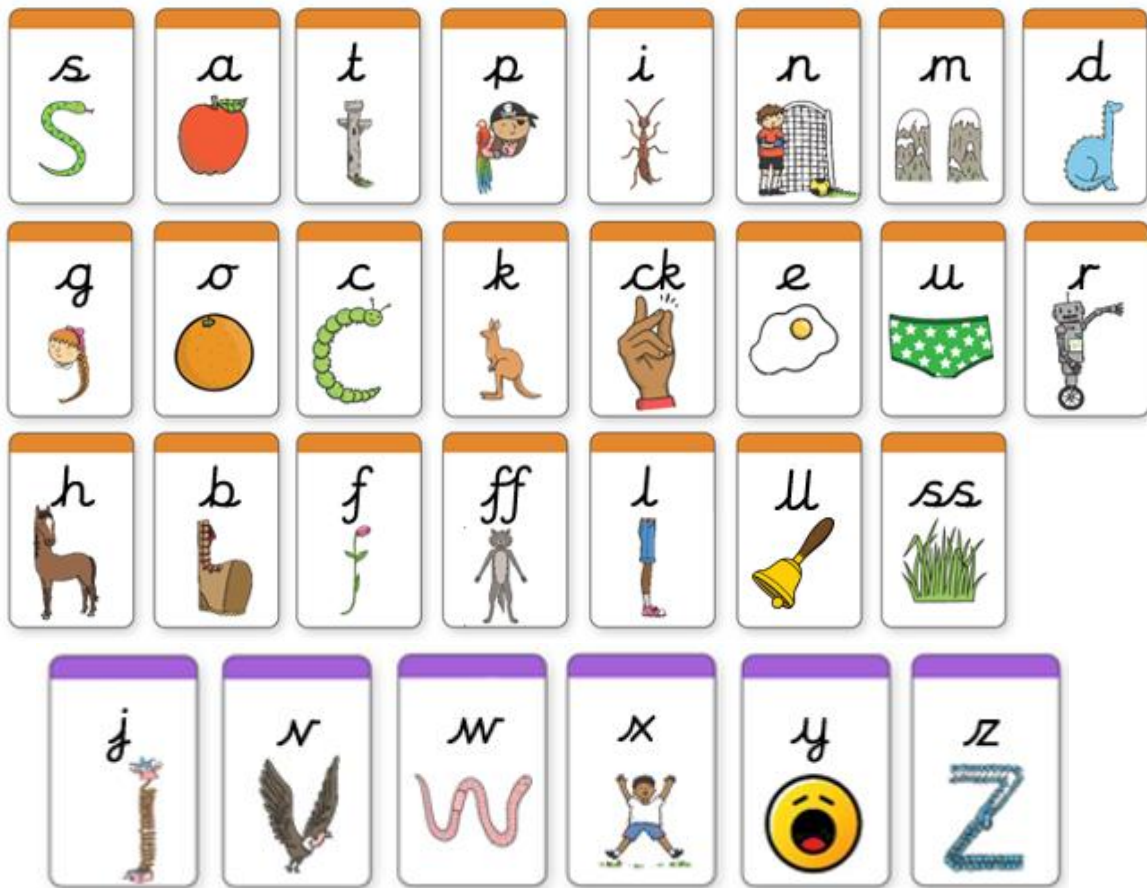


Friday 15th January 2021

This is zz.

It has 2 letters but it makes 1 sound, this is called a digraph. This digraph goes at the end of words.

The Phonics Fairy says - "zz, zz, buzz, zz, zz, buzz."

The action for zz is pretending your hand is a bee buzzing around!

zz has 2 letters, they are friends and hold hands, this means when we write this sound the letters are joined.
