First we will all play a game of “Who wants to be a millionaire”? All you have to do is write down what you think is the correct spelling for the 10 words. Can you get to £1,000,000?

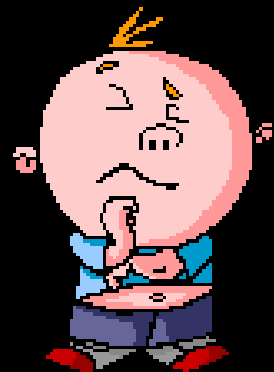
For your independent work you have to:
