

Dear Parents / Carers,

We are so disappointed that due to current circumstances we won't be seeing most of your children in class this term.

In Year 3 and 4, we will be delivering three 30 minute online learning sessions every day. These will be Maths, English and an Afternoon Session relating to Topic, Science, RE and Story Time.

These will be at the following times:

9.10am – 9.40am: Maths

10.30am – 11.00am: English

1.15pm – 1.45pm: Afternoon Session

These online sessions will be delivered from the classroom so that those children who are in school can access the learning at the same time as their class peers at home.

Children who are home learning are encouraged to share their work via Google Classrooms. This will be read and feedback will be given as a whole class. We will be commenting on:

1. What the children did well in the lesson, celebrating examples of good work.
2. Clarifying any common misunderstandings and mistakes.
3. Identifying next steps in learning.

In addition to the home learning activities, please continue to read regularly with your child. All the children have access to our online platform Rising Stars.
