REMOTE LEARNING

Many thanks to all of the parents who have completed the survey on how we are implementing the remote learning offer for the children. The responses have been very encouraging and we thank those parents who have been very generous in their praise for the speed in which we set up the systems and how well the live teaching sessions have been received by both children and parents.

unfortunately this has led to frustration but please bear with it as it will get easier the more we all use it.

A question was asked about why we are not using Google Meet function within Google Classroom. The simple fact is that this does not work properly on the systems we have within school. There is an issue with sound and responses that we are unable, at this current time, to overcome. In the future our aim is to move over completely, however, we want to concentrate on what we are doing very well right now. Therefore the use of Zoom will continue for live teaching, with as indicated in my letter last week, streamlined codes and information in one place. You will have received an email outlining the timetable for the week of Zoom codes, times and teachers. I hope this is now clearer for you and all in one place.

The engagement for the live teaching and completing of work by the children has been fantastic and we would like this to continue. As stated in the letter this was the preferred option of the majority of parents. I have attached to this newsletter two guides for parents relating to the downloading and uploading of work to Google Classrooms. Hopefully, these will help you find it easier to cope with.

We will be moving to support some small group work and some individual sessions for reading, etc. now we are into a proper routine and mostly settled with the systems we are using. Your child's class teachers will be in touch regarding how this will work for your child's class.

As I said to the children last week, our Value for Life this term is Perseverance. This is most pertinent for this term as we must all try our very best to keep going and not give up on what we have to do or find difficult or troublesome. These will be good life lessons for the children and I hope this value will be demonstrated at home. If you are able to send any photos or comments about this to me for inclusion in the newsletter and for me to use during worships that would be great.
