


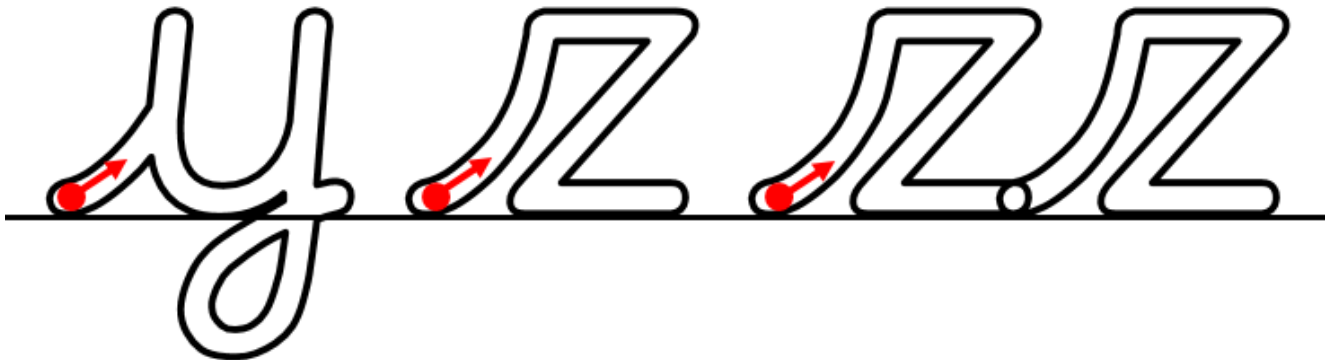


Reception Phonics

This week we have learnt 3 new sounds, practise them at home.

Sound	Visual	Action	Letter Formation Rhyme
y	yawn 	Put hand to mouth as if yawning	Whoosh up, under the yawn, back up, down and curl
z	zip 	Pretend to pull up a zip on a coat	Whoosh up and zig, zag, zig.
zz	buzzy bee 	Grasp all fingers on your thumb. Move it around in front to represent a bee buzzing around	This sound has 2 letters so we say that they are friends and hold hands. There are no letter formation rhymes for digraphs or trigraphs (sounds with 2/ 3 letters).
