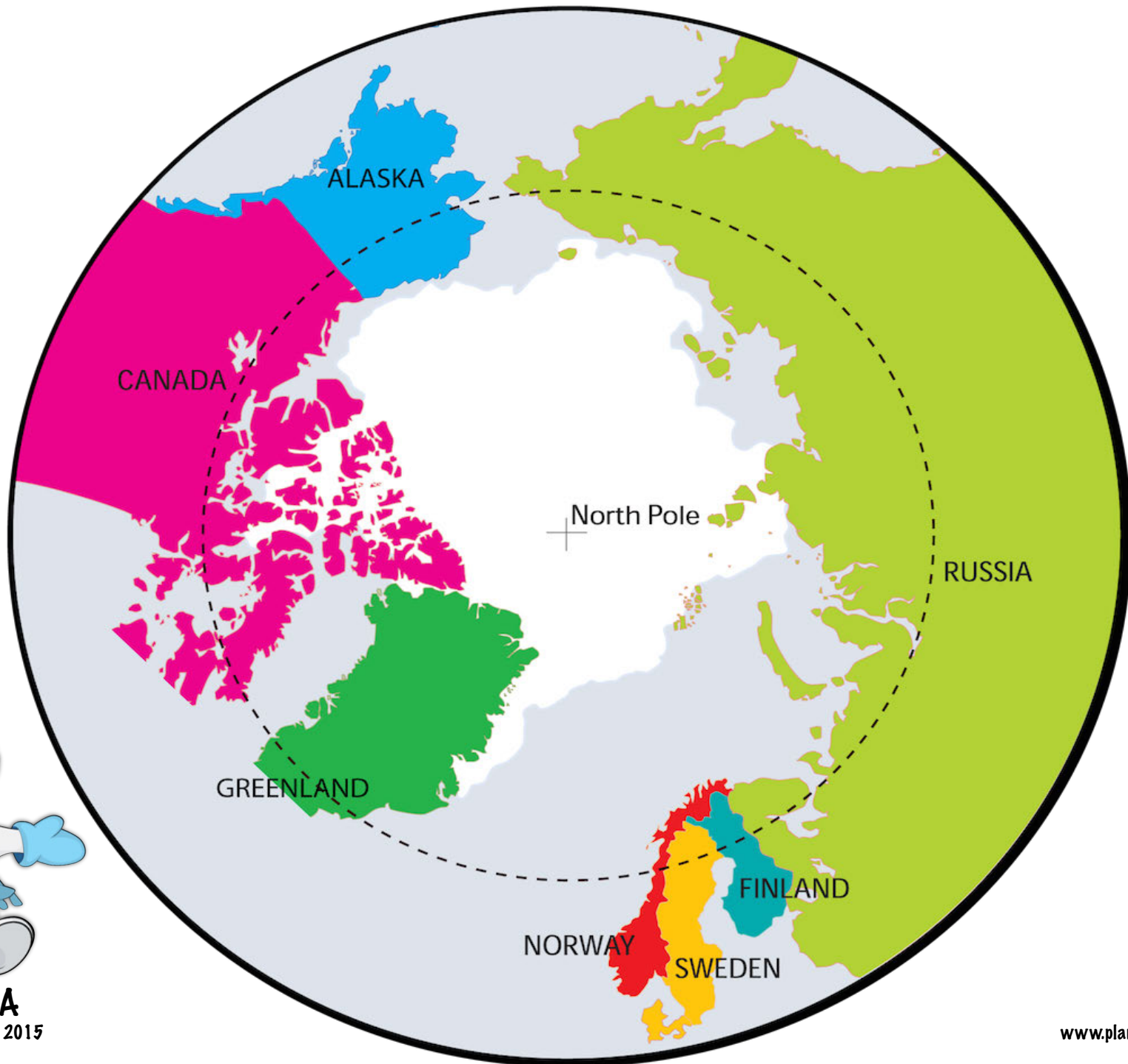

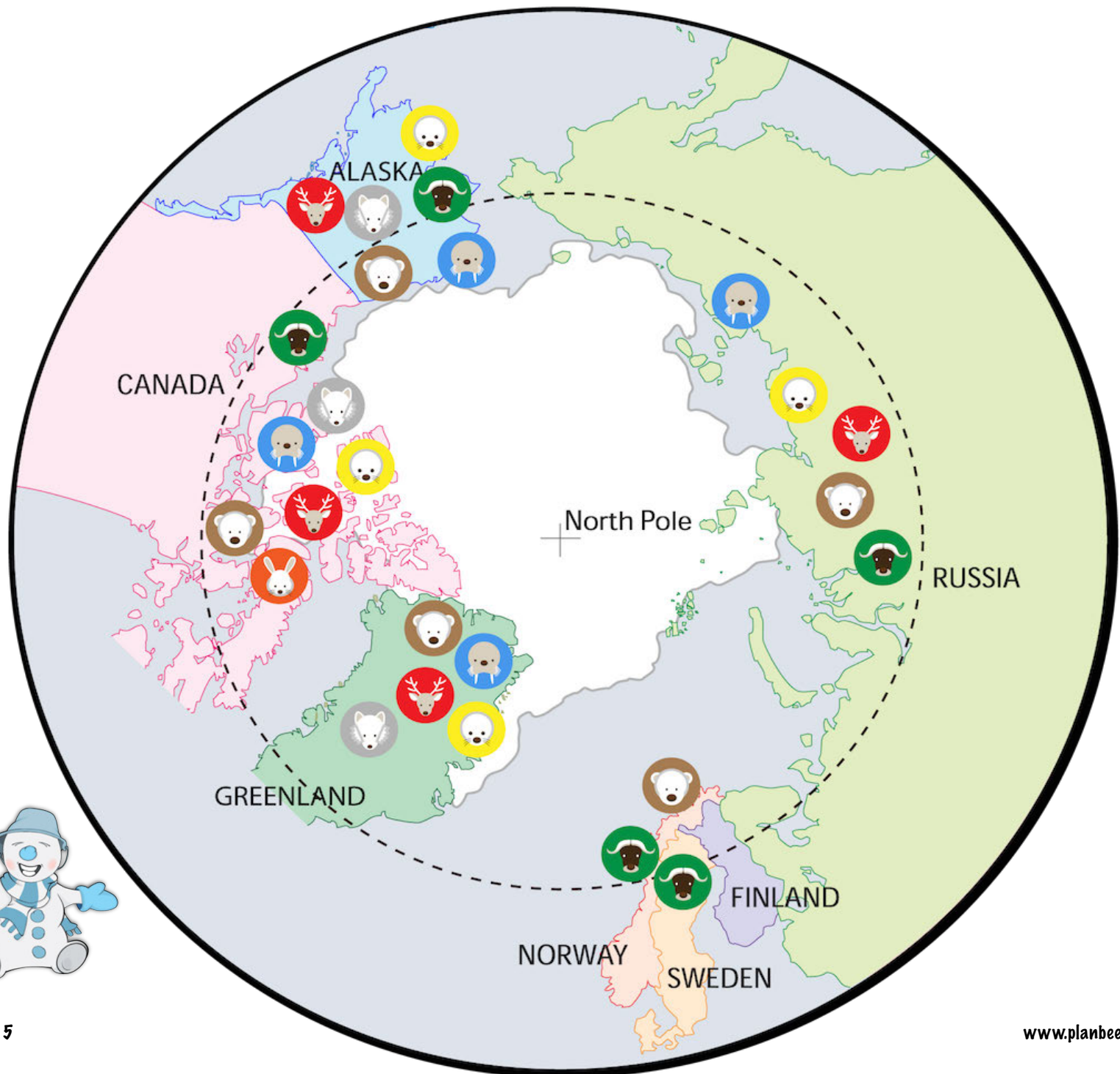

I am a reindeer. I live in Alaska, Greenland, Canada and Russia.



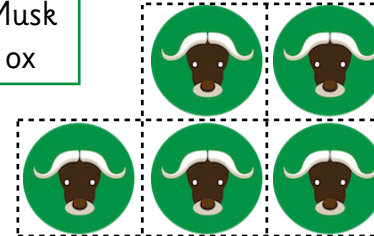

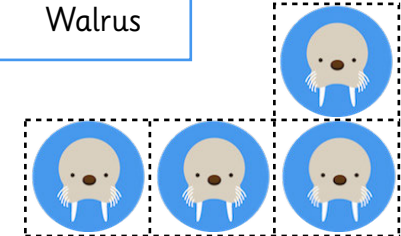

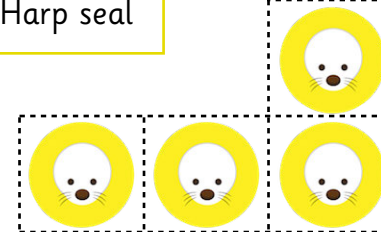

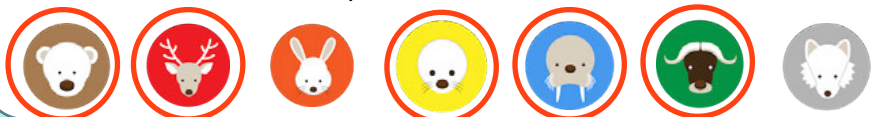

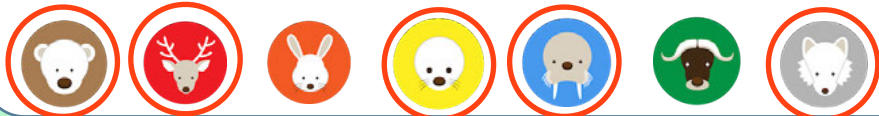
