The action for **ay** is putting your hands out to the side, as if asking a question.

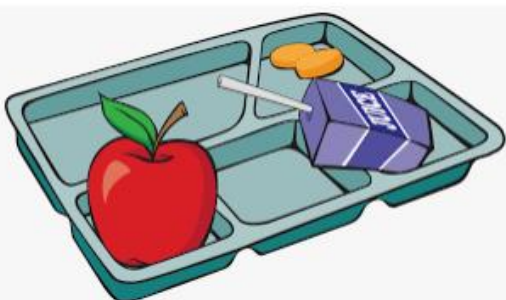
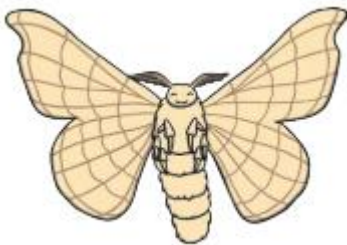

ay has 2 letters, they are friends and hold hands, this means when we write this sound the letters are joined.

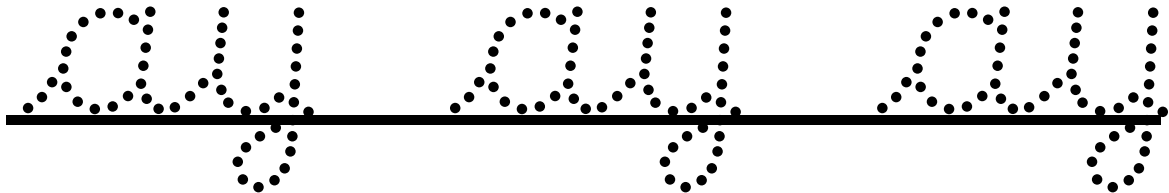


The Phonics Fairy says...
