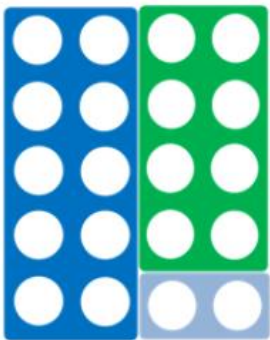
Let's get warmed up and sing this song about the numbers that make 10.

In the song, the numbers that go together to make 10 are called number bonds. The word bond means that they are joined or connected.

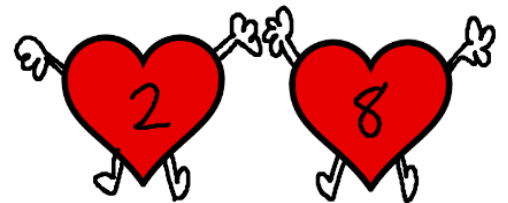

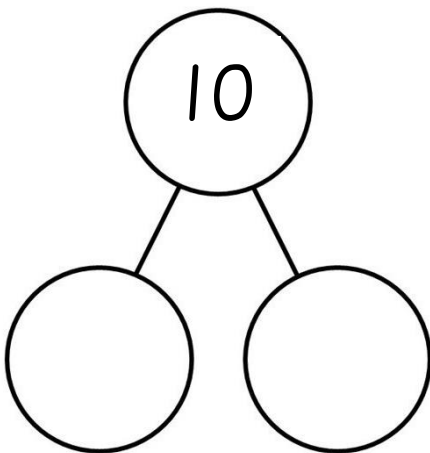
8 and 2 is a number bond to 10.

8 and 2 are joined or bonded together to always make 10. 8 never goes with another number.

Sometimes we can even think of the numbers that make 10 as **numbers in love**! They are together for their whole lives making the number 10.



Let's look at the numbers 8, 2 and 10 in a Part, Part, Whole model.



8 is a part, 2 is a part and 10 is the whole.

Can you remember the others?
