

This week we are learning all about the number **10!**





What do you notice about the number 10?
It has two digits, a 1 and a 0. It is really important that the 1 *always* comes first because it is 1 block of ten. The 0 is there to tell you it is ten and nothing else.

Ten is both 1 ten and 10 ones. Can you see how the individual block lines have disappeared?





Look at your hands and practise counting all your fingers.
Start with your hands down then move your fingers up one
at a time.



We have already learned how to write the numerals in the
number 10. Have a practice writing the 1 and 0 to form 10.
