### The Torah

A Torah scroll contains the first five books of the Bible. It is written in Hebrew, the language Jewish people use for worship. The Torah scroll is wound on two wooden rollers. It is either in a cover decorated with silver bells and crowns or mounted in a magnificent wooden case. Jewish people do not touch the Torah. Instead they use a pointer to read it called a Yad.

Why is the Torah important to Jewish people?
