
## Reception Home Learning 22<sup>nd</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup> February 2021

Here are some activity ideas linking to this week's theme.

Please choose at least one activity from the list below, or you could make up your own, to complete each day.

Make a 3d dinosaur model – you could use boxes, Lego, K-Nex etc!	Make saltdough dinosaur bones or fossils, you could bury them and dig them up like a palaeontologist!	Join in with Cosmic Kids Dinosaur Yoga
Design your own dinosaur, will it have wings, feathers, spikes, plates? Try and label it too	Use books or the internet to find out some amazing dinosaur facts	Explore a Dinosaur museum virtual tour on the internet
Use cotton buds to make a dinosaur skeleton	Practise your phonics by playing the Dinosaur eggs game online at ictgames.com	Make a dinosaur using 2d shapes - circle, square, rectangle, triangle, oval, pentagon, semi-circle etc
Make playdough dinosaurs, you could use pasta to make the spikes!	Find out how dinosaurs moved, can you move like a dinosaur? You could try stomping, running, flying!	Create a dinosaur egg! There's lots of ideas online - papier mache, freezing coloured water in a balloon, decorating a polystyrene egg etc
Do some dinosaur themed cooking. You could make footprint cookies or a jelly swamp!  If you are able to plea	Make a dinosaur land, maybe you could add a volcano. You could add vinegar and bicarbonate of soda to make it erupt!	Try to find some dinosaur stories either at home or online and enjoy reading them together
