The action for oo is wafting your hand in front of your nose, as if smelling a bad smell!

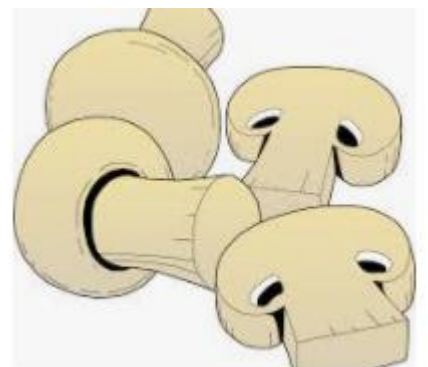


Let's watch this song to help us remember our new sound...

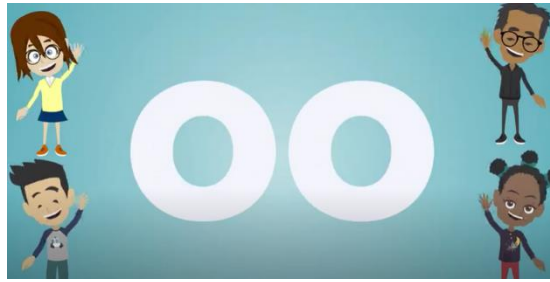









Watch this song and listen for words with an oo sound...
