

The action for **oo** is making 2 circles with your fingers and putting them on your eyes like glasses!




Let's watch this song to help us remember our new sound ...

We love books too! What is your favourite book?




oo and oo look the same but they sound different.

Watch this song and listen for words with an **oo** and **oo** sound...



oo has 2 letters, they are friends and hold hands, this means when we write this sound the letters are joined.
