


We have spent the last couple of days sharing practically with biscuits and eggs and other things at home. Today we are going to continue to share by drawing pictures to help us find out the answer.

What is 6 shared by 2?



6 shared by 2 is




6 shared by 2 is 3!




9 shared by 3 is
