
When we share we have to do so fairly and equally. This means everyone gets the same amount. We can use the 'one for you, one for me, one for you, one for me', method.

Today I have 3 dino biscuits. Try and share them.




3 shared by 2 is

That's right. It's not fair. How many are left over?


What should we do with this extra biscuit? How could we
