# **REMOTE LEARNING**

We will be continuing the teaching of the children remotely until we are fully back in school. There is an announcement later today but as I have mentioned before, we do not have prior notice of any announcements in advance. I will be in touch as soon as we know the outcome and when we will be expecting to welcome the children back. There has been lots of speculation on what to expect from the return to school and the other measures which may be put in place

to help the 'catch up' for the children. I am sure this will be swift for the children at Almondsbury due to the very high engagement of remote learning over the past 6 weeks. Thank you for supporting the children as you have been doing and continuing to do so during this term.

You will have received the latest Zoom codes for the live teaching sessions (if they have changed) and I look forward to joining some of the lessons as I did before half term.

### **PARENTS EVENINGS**

As we have not had the majority of children in school this term we have decided to delay the Parents Evenings until the end of this term. This will allow time for us to see the children in school, if that is what is decided, after 8 March. We will hold the parental discussions with the teachers via Zoom, as we did last November. The booking system will be open shortly on the school website link. You will have your username and passwords from last November to enable you to book. You will receive an email when the booking is open. If you would rather have a telephone conversation please email your child's class teacher to request this. Of course, the conversations may be very different this time around and will focus on the children's wellbeing as well as their academic progress during home learning, plus work we have received from the children in school.
