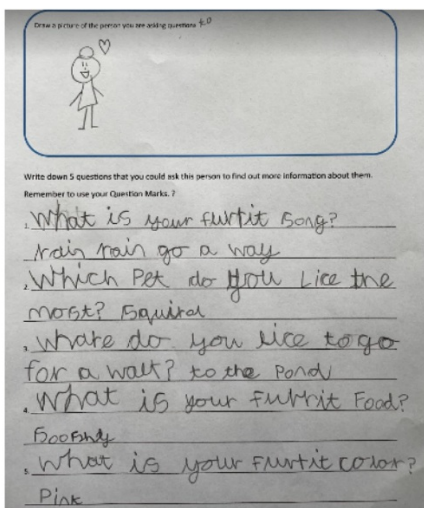


Yesterday we were using question marks at the end of questions that we asked.

In 2016.

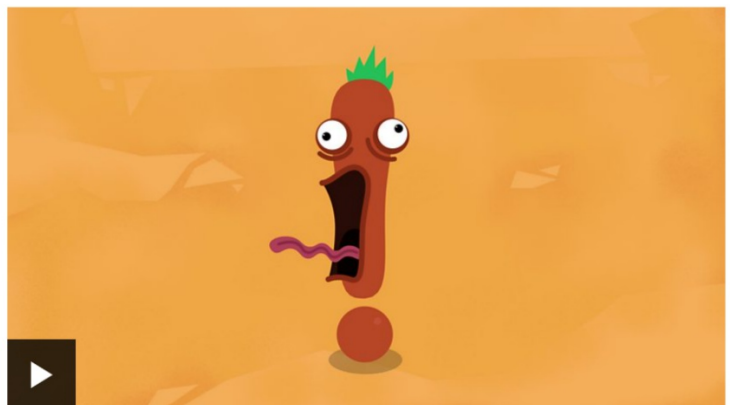
You used different question starters
