Start using question marks and exclamation marks more in our day to day writing

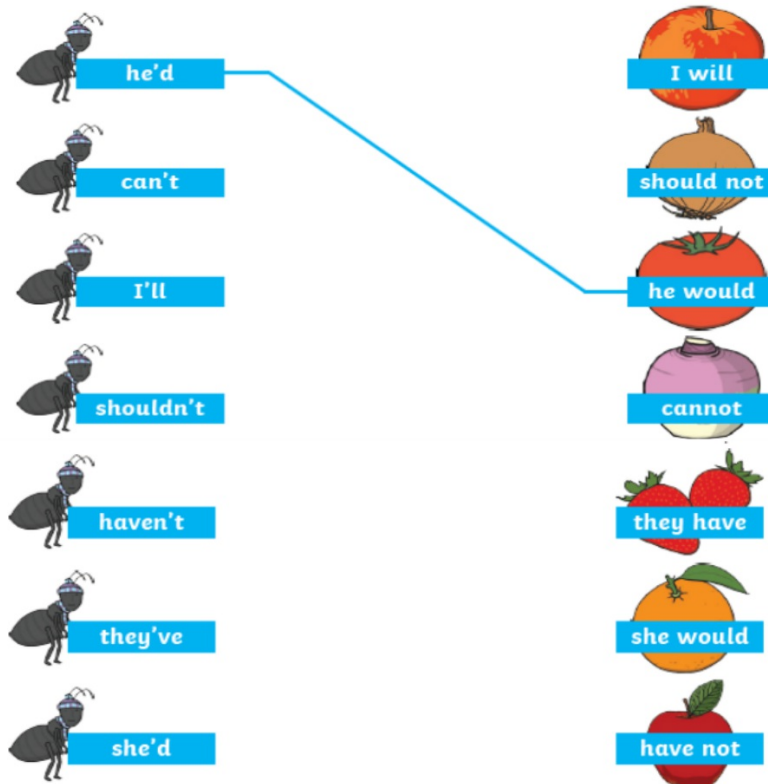
